Ed had been preaching for 68 years and broadcasting for almost 50 years when he passed away May 16, 2011.

The Faith Once Delivered

“Beloved while I was giving all diligence to write unto you concerning our common salvation, I was constrained to write unto you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith once for all delivered unto the saints.” Jude 3. We have a common salvation. It is not common in the sense of being ordinary; it is an extraordinary salvation.

However there are many aspects as to why it is common. For one thing it is the same for men as it is for women. A man wrote one time to say that the gospel that is preached on this broadcast is needed by all the sex in religion. I think he meant to say sects S.E.C.T.S. But he wrote sex S.E.X. Whichever he meant he was right in both cases. People in all religious sects need the gospel that is preached on the broadcast. In fact the more sectarian they are, the more they need it. But it is also needed by all the sex in religion and out of religion. It is needed by every man, every woman, every boy, every girl, every they, every them, every who, every whom, every he, every she, every it, every one, everybody. He said, “I give all diligence to write unto you concerning our common salvation.” It is common also because we have a common Savior. Jesus can be and must be the Savior of all mankind. There is no other. Jesus said, “No one cometh unto the Father but by Me.” And Peter said, “Neither is there salvation in another: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” Unless Jesus was grossly mistaken - and unless Peter was completely bum fozzled, bewildered, mystified and freaked out by what the Holy Spirit told him, there is absolutely no other way for anybody, anywhere, any time in any generation, to go to heaven other than through Jesus Christ. I write unto you concerning our common salvation. It is a common salvation also because we have a common plan of salvation. Peter tells us that common plan the day the Church began on the day of Pentecost: “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” Now isn’t that refreshing? Peter not only told them this, but then he told them it was not only for them, but for their children, and he told them it was not only for their descendants, but to all that were afar off, and not only for those who were afar off, but for all as many as the Lord would call unto Him. Truly we have a common salvation because one plan fits all. I write unto you concerning our common salvation. Consider also it is a common salvation because we belong

to a common Church. There is only one Church in the New Testament. Jesus said I will build My Church. There is no other Church recognized by New Testament writers. I want to be sure I am a member of that Church. If there is any denomination in addition to the church the Lord established mentioned in the Bible, let me know where it is, or how many there are and I want to join every one of them. I want to belong to any Church that is found in the Bible, whether it be one or a dozen; because I don’t want to miss out on anything. On the day the Church was born the Lord added unto the Church in that day those that were saved. Jude said that it was a common salvation. It is common also because we have a common name.

Doesn’t it sound strange to read the New Testament and never find modern day denominational names? Listen to these strange names from the New Testament. The disciples were called Christians first at Antioch. Almost thou persuade me to be a Christian. If any suffer as a Christian let him not be ashamed. Where did you ever read of Protestants or Catholics in the Bible? If there are Protestants and Catholics in the Bible, let me know what book, what chapter and what verse so states and I want to join both groups. Ladies and Gentlemen, I don’t want to miss out on anything. But until then, why can’t we be satisfied to call ourselves Christians, or saints and nothing else? I write unto you concerning our common salvation. It is common also because we have a common message. This is the Bible and the Bible only. There is no other book or written communication of any kind that has been given to us by the inspiration of God. John tells us on the last page of the Bible, “For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, if any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.” These words on the last page of the Bible stand there like a red flag, a big flashing sign that says danger, a warning to all who would write or believe or teach any other document as the inspired word of God. I write unto you concerning our common salvation. Now after speaking of our common salvation Jude says, “I was constrained to write unto you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith once delivered to the saints.” For one thing this faith we contend for was delivered. It was not invented by earthly men. Men did not figure this faith out for themselves. The faith was delivered. Paul tells the Galatians where he obtained the message that he preached when he said, “I make known unto you brethren the gospel which was preached by me that it is not after men, neither was I taught it, but it came to me by revelation of Jesus Christ. We have all received the same message. The problem is we have not all delivered the same message that we received. Go to the meeting place of some denominations during the week and open the pulpit Bible and read Mark 16:16. “He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved.” Go back on Sunday and he will tell you, “He that believeth and is saved shall be baptized.” He has not delivered what he received. He delivers something else. Notice also that there has only been one deliv-

ery. It was once delivered unto the saints. There is only one delivery. The truth of God was not delivered twice just once. The Bible is only book where you can find the way to heaven. There is no other. John said after the Resurrection that these things are written that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God and believing ye might have life in His name. There is just one delivery. So when someone tells you they have another book besides the Bible that is inspired of God you know that you are talking to a false prophet. There is no other book. As God looks down on the world today there is no chance that He will send another gospel. We do things now that would have been miraculous to people a few years ago. God will never say, "Well it looks like I will have to invent a high tech plan for this high tech age. They need a high tech Church and a high tech gospel."

Ladies and Gentlemen, our high tech age has produced high tech sinners, who are headed for a high tech Hell. God will not give these high tech smart alecks a customized plan of salvation. There will be no designer Church or a designer plan of salvation except the one designed in the New Testament. It is the duty of the Church to send the word out to a world that lives in the suburbs of Hell. But not only is the faith delivered and once delivered it is delivered unto the saints. Paul tell us in first Timothy that the Church is the pillar and ground of truth. The Bible has been deposited by God into the hands of the Church. We have a secretary of State, a secretary of education, a secretary of defense, a secretary of various departments, but there is no secretary of the Bible. That responsibility has been given to the saints. The Church cannot change the message. The Church as the pillar and ground of truth must support the truth and hold it up to a lost world. Ladies and Gentlemen, remember it was said, "Beloved I have given all diligence today to write to you, concerning our common salvation, I was constrained to write unto you that you should contend earnestly for the faith once delivered unto the saints." John Maseka, evangelist of the Messenger Church of Christ in Zambia

We are fine by the grace and also the children. Extra carefulness is what we are practicing now so we are on our fit and going every week but travelling once a week. Two outstanding cases we recorded are the elderly woman in her 70s and the Jehovah's Witness' couple we baptized this month. Ofardjator is a village where we taught the people about Christ this month. Very scaring as the village is due to the numerous shrines there, Gospel Preachers do not bother to go there but God led us there and were able to teach Christ to them and had one man who do not go with the people but because he has no job, he had to pretend as if he was with them. He told us he will leave the village and that "dirty" job and worship God if he could get a place out of the village, which we were working on till a native brother has pledged to help in this. Horni is also another village with some five churches but leaders of three of these churches told us work there is terrible as the people don't seem to understand the difference between God and the gods they worship. According to them, people can go worship their gods and attend worship service the same Sunday. We had some 6 men and 2 women to study the Bible on God's Plan of Salvation with and through the questions, one man asked us who created the god they worship, and with answers from the Bible, 1 Corinthians 8:4-6 was the powerful and the most understandable scripture for them to be convinced and be quite to listen the more. Eventually, we had 3 of them (a woman and 2 of the men) been baptized the following Sunday when they attended church with us at Pack Side. We have been seeing things for ourselves since we started going far deep into the forest and tell you, the situation is an eyesore one; many children without food to eat let alone, clothing to wear. One parent has between 4 and 9 children and all they do is subsistence farming which does not pay. Please, we are begging you for some used clothing for children and for women, especially. Help clothe these innocent children and their parents to attend church service, which they claim is the one of the main reason why they don't go to church.
