HELP! HELP!

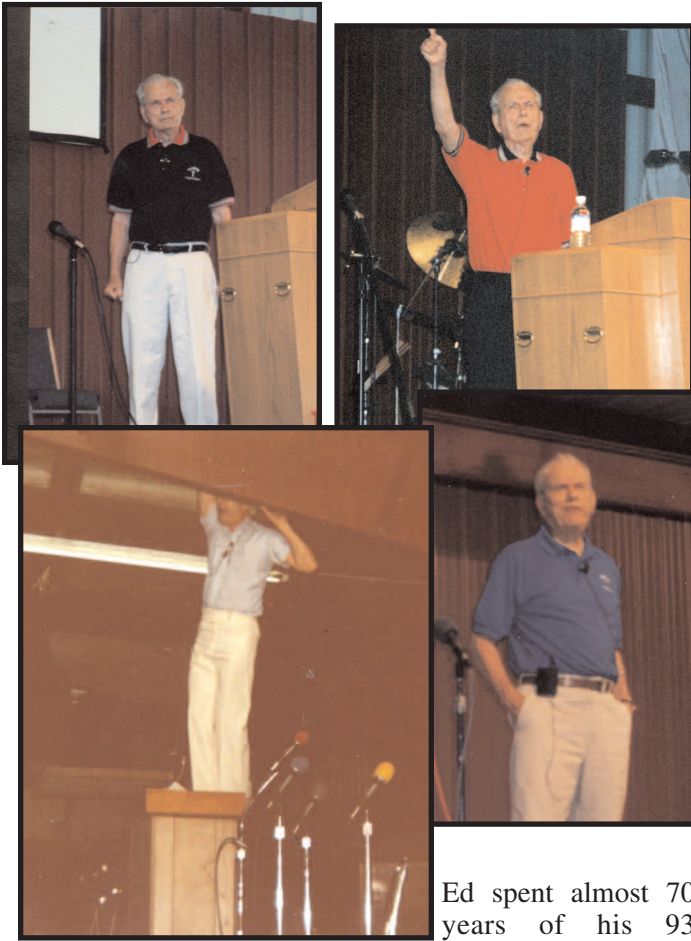

I don't recall that we ever had this small amount after paying the radio bills over the past 30 years.

I have doubled my giving and I'm praying without ceasing for God to intercede so I don't have to drop radio broadcasts. So I decided to go to you the listeners, the contributors, and the heartbeat of GIJAPA. If our funds do not increase by December 31, 2014, I will have to drop two 50,000 watt stations in US—KRVN, Lexington, NE; KDWN, Las Vegas, NV and one Short-wave station - Radio Africa.

KNOW THEM OVER YOU

Here are two statements of Paul regarding leadership that ought to be noted. Paul exhorts us in First Thessalonians to know them that labor among you and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you. Do you really know them that labor among you? I served a congregation one time where a strange thing happened. As I was shaking the brethren out one Sunday morning after services one of the deacons stopped to chat for a few moments. While we were talking one of the elders passes by and I reached out a hand to shake his hand and for some unknown reason I said to the elder, "Joe Blow, do you know John Doe here?" Joe Blow, the elder, said, no he didn't. So I introduced Joe Blow to John Doe. The first thing Joe Blow said to John

Doe was an invitation to attend services. Joe Blow told John Doe that he was glad he was with us today and invited him to come back sometime. All of a sudden I realized that not only did Joe Blow not know that John Doe was a Deacon he did not even know that he was a Christian. I did not ask the deacon, but I have a feeling that he did not know the elder either. Think of that for awhile. An elder and a deacon in the same congregation and neither one of them knew each other. Paul said that we are to know them who labor among us. Do you know who your elders and deacons are? In this day and time this advice ought to be applied to the television and radio preachers as well. They come into our homes every week. Do you really know them? I mean know them for what they are and what they teach? Many a person in the Church of Christ recognizes all of the electronic preachers as faithful "preachers" of the Word. They really don't know them. Do you know that not a single nationally known television preacher tells people to do what Peter told people to do on the day of Pentecost. Namely repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Do you know that not one nationally known television preacher tells people that the Lord's Supper needs to be observed every first day of the week? Did you ever hear any of them refer to Acts 20:7? And upon the first day of the week when we were gathered together to break bread... How well do you know them that presume to teach you and admonish you? When did you ever hear a nationally known television preacher plead for the unity of all lovers of God and talk about the sin of denominational names? Paul said, "KNOW THESE PEOPLE." I hope that you know them a little better now. It seems that those who don't preach the truth are the ones who have all the television and radio programs. Some of our people say that the local Church is where all the action is. I wish the devil understood that. The action for cults and denominations is in the electronic arena. They bring it into our homes and our people bring it into our congregations. Then when some of our preachers-a few of them anyway-tell people what the Bible really says about the plan of salvation the message is unacceptable. The message is unacceptable because our people really don't know them who teach and admonish them on television and the radio. Another thought on leadership is from the fifth chapter of First Timothy. He said that some men's sins are evident going before them into judgment; some men also they follow after. While Paul may have been talking about the eldership in particular this statement has far reaching effects also. Some men's sins are evident. Some people are evidently not qualified to be elders and those sins are noted before any examination of the candidate. Some are not revealed until the candidate is examined further. But this principle is also true as far as the Judgment Day is concerned. Some men's sins are evident going before them into Judgment. No one will be the least bit surprised if Adolph Hitler goes to Hell. Where else is there for a man like that to go? It is evident. Some men's sins are evident going before them into Judgment. There will be no way to escape. Their sins will be evident to God and man. When the Allied armies liberated the prisoners in Dachau as well as other camps where people were slaughtered, some of the

Nazi guards tried to disguise themselves by putting on the garb of prisoners. They did not fool anyone because of their fat faces. Anyone could see that they were well fed. There was no way to hide. The marks of sin will be there; not only evident in the here and now, but evident then. Some men's sins are evident going before them into Judgment. But for some they follow after. There are some that are adroit in hiding an unfaithful life. They appeared to be Christians. They were faithful in attendance, and other important work of the Lord's and His Church. They managed to keep their hypocrisy well hidden but all will be revealed on that day. Some men's sins are evident going into Judgment and some they follow after.

My very dear Sister Naomi, How are you? We are fine. I was out of Solwezi for the past month. I took my daughter Melody on tuberculosis treatment to the mission hospital in Mwinilunga district, about 260 km away from our home town Solwezi. Her legs were swollen when she started taking the drugs.

I am happy to tell you that, on Monday, 8th September 2014, she reported to school. She has reduced coughing and chest pains. She is not very weak as before. She has gained weight and able to wash her clothes. Thank you so much for your continued prayers for her quick recovery. Sad news, we have no Church of Christ in Mwinilunga district of Northwestern province of Zambia. We are happy our daughter is improving. May the Lord use our daughter’s illness for us to see and know this place to open the door for evangelism? We are going back to Mwinilunga in December this year 2014, for review. I would appreciate to have Bibles and tracts to help us to find good contacts.

Beloved Sister Naomi, We are always glad with your love, patience and humility. We thank God for your understanding. The missionaries sold the only church plot and left after years of spending but to no avail. It was when the few faithful brethren heard that the good Lord had used me to convert several Muslims and a whole Pentecostal church into the Lord’s church in my home country of Ghana that they immediately came for me.

To the glory of God we now have six congregations here apart from the one planted in the Cassamance region of Senegal and also four in Sierra Leone which I keep visiting year by year to assist the work. This nation of The Gambia needs someone like me who is willing to sacrifice and knows much of Islam and their Quran apart from the Bible.

Ahmed D., a dangerous Islamic fundamentalist based in South Africa print books against the Bible and Christianity and distribute freely in all parts of Africa. Some of his books are entitled 50,000 errors in the Bible, Crucifixion and several others. When I got hold of them, I studied carefully and printed a tract based on their Quran to answer all his questions. When the Muslim youths in this country read it, they began questioning their leaders about Islam and their Quran.

I was called upon for questioning at the ministry of religious affairs. At the end, I was warned not to distribute those tracts anymore. God is truly on our side. I have so far trained seven preachers of which five are Gambians. My wife I brought from Ghana was sick and since I was having no funds to cater for her expenses, she had to die leaving on me our three children. Please always remember us in your prayers, sister. To God alone be the glory through Christ Jesus, Amen.
