THE CHURCH CHANNEL COVERAGE:

GIJAPA is expanded by the Church Channel, a powerful television station broadcasting to the people of Nairobi with a population of over 3.8 million. The city is a multi-cultural city, the native folks along with a large number of people immigrating from Asia, India, Pakistan and Britain making the English language widespread.

Main religion in Nairobi is Christianity. Kenya is predominantly a Christian society. Denominations in Kenya are about 45% Protestant and about 33% Catholics. They include the Anglican Church of Kenya, and the Presbyterian, Reformed, Methodist, Baptist, Lutheran, and Pentecostal churches. About 10% of the population adheres to indigenous beliefs while Muslim adherents account for about 10%. Islam is a major religion in Kenya. Followers include both Sunni and Shi'ite Muslims. The cost is only \$49 per 30 minute broadcast for the first three months, then it is \$59. Please pray for GIJAPA that this outreach to over 3.8 million will reach and teach the lost and bring them into the Kingdom of God.

SOME facts & figures for 2014

1. **RADIO BROADCASTS:** 65% of GIJAPA's income goes to pay for the 17 broadcasts heard each Sunday around the world; 2014 had 52 Sundays therefore GIJAPA was heard 884 times. (See page one for The Radio Log.)

2. **INCOME:**

- 70 Churches gave 35% of income.
- 432 Individuals gave 65% of income.
- 5 Churches and 7 Individuals gave over \$5,000 each.
- Our income for 2014 was \$39,028 less than it was in 2013.
- Our expenses for 2014 were \$2,250 more than we received.

3. **BIBLES and BIBLE STUDIES:**

- 1,111 large print Bibles \$10 each sent to prisoners \$11,110.
- First 5 lessons of (30) Studies in the Bible - Genesis-Revelation—is sent with Bible and upon completion they are sent the following lessons:

4. **POSTAGE:** 1,111 Large Print Bibles sent to Prisoners \$3.65 each = \$4,055.

- 306 Hard back pew Bibles \$5.00 each—24 Boxes sent out of US* @ \$80.50 each = \$1,932.

- 35 boxes of used clothes sent out of US* @ \$80.50 each = \$2,817.

- 6,000 copies of GIJAPA monthly newsletter and insert envelopes \$1,700 to print and \$700 to mail total \$2,400 a month.

HOW TO GET INTO CHRIST
